

EXEMPTIONS ENGLISH LANGUAGE CERTIFICATION

You will **not** need to present a language proficiency certificate if:

- You are a **native English speaker** coming from one of the following countries: Antigua and Barbuda, Australia, Bahamas, Barbados, Belize, Canada, Dominica, Grenada, Guyana, Ireland, Jamaica, Malta, New Zealand, St Kitts and Nevis, St Lucia, St Vincent and the Grenadines, Trinidad and Tobago, United Kingdom, United States of America;
- You obtained a qualification (either your entry qualification or higher qualification) by completing your **previous education entirely in English** at an institution located in one of the following Countries:
 - Antigua and Barbuda, Australia, Bahamas, Barbados, Belize, Canada, Dominica, Grenada, Guyana, Ireland, Jamaica, Malta, New Zealand, St Kitts and Nevis, St Lucia, St Vincent and the Grenadines, Trinidad and Tobago, United Kingdom, USA;
 - Countries of the European Union and of the Schengen Area
- You obtained one of the following **entry qualification completely held in English**:
 - *International Baccalaureate (IBDP)*,
 - *European Baccalaureate (EB)*,
 - *General Certificate of Education (GCE) or International General Certificate of Education (IGCE)*,
 - *High School Diploma* corredato da 3 US Advanced Placements (APs) con punteggio da 3 a 5.
